Blanco Y Negro is a new group fronted by three musicians, conga-player Eliel Lazo, bassist Yasser Morejón and drummer Jonas Johansen. This vital music, a mixture of Cuban and Danish, was recorded in Havana in the Cuban National Broadcast Company's studio 4 - the same building from which Castro spoke to the people every day, which made it difficult to leave the building due to rigid security. However everything worked out, and after ten days of recording and mixing, this CD was born.

Jonas Johansen explains that the normal Western ear will find the music very Cuban, whereas most Cuban's hear it as very jazzy - with a Cuban flavor. The musicians feel that it sounds like them selves. Judge for yourself! And enjoy!
